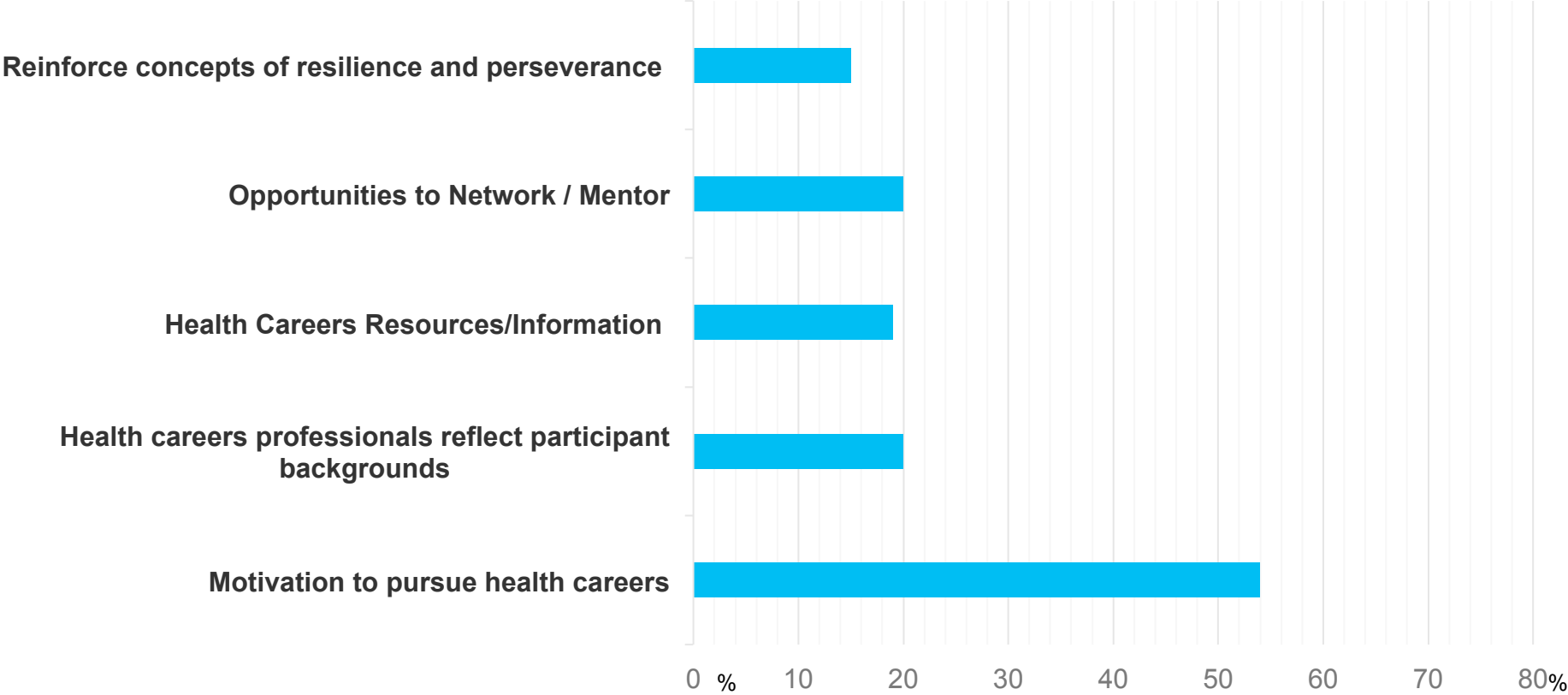

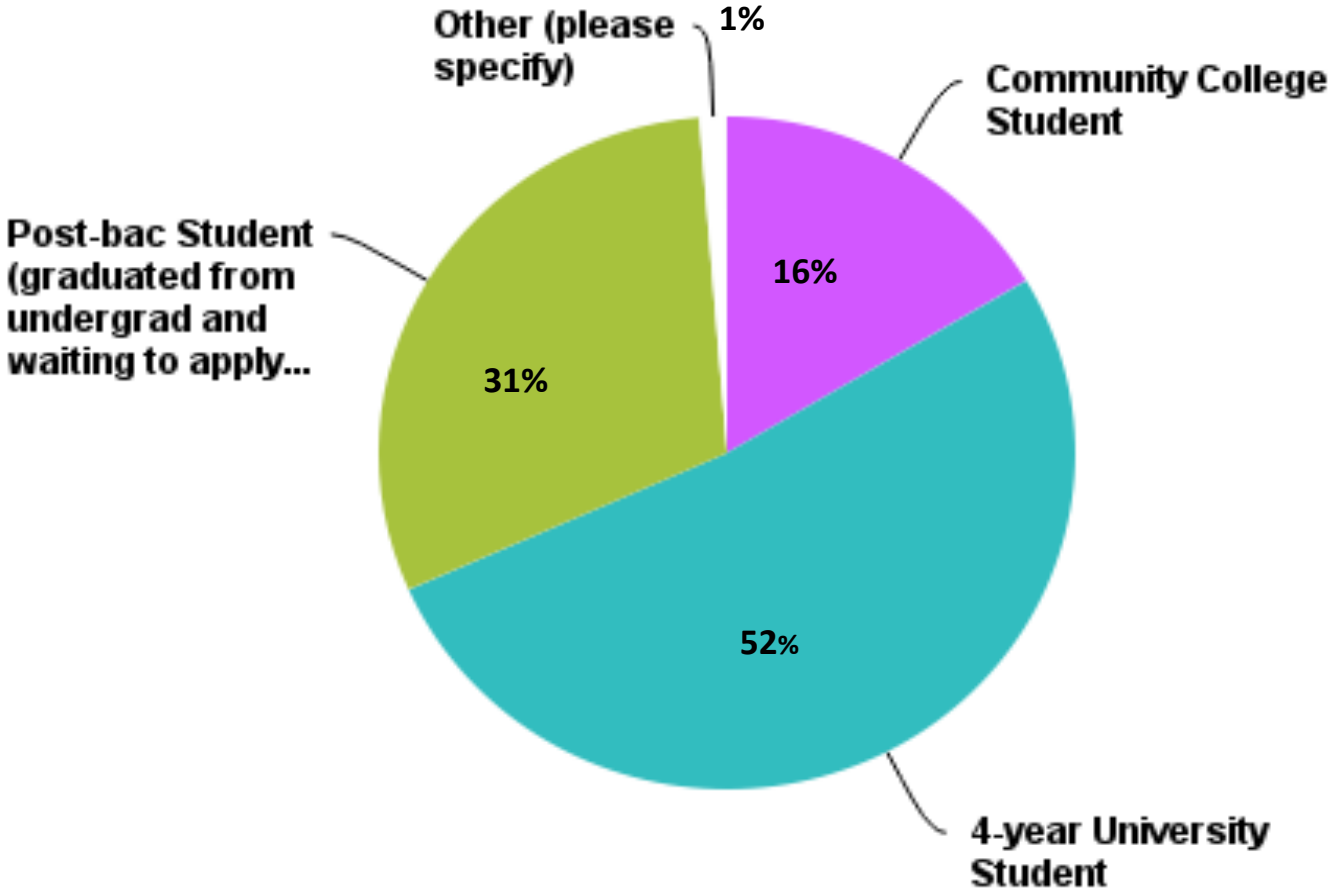

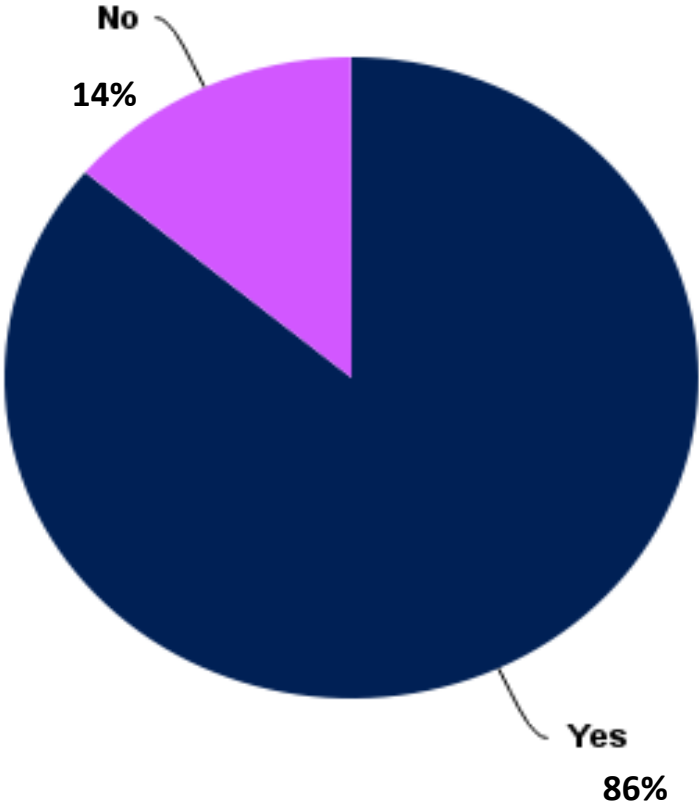
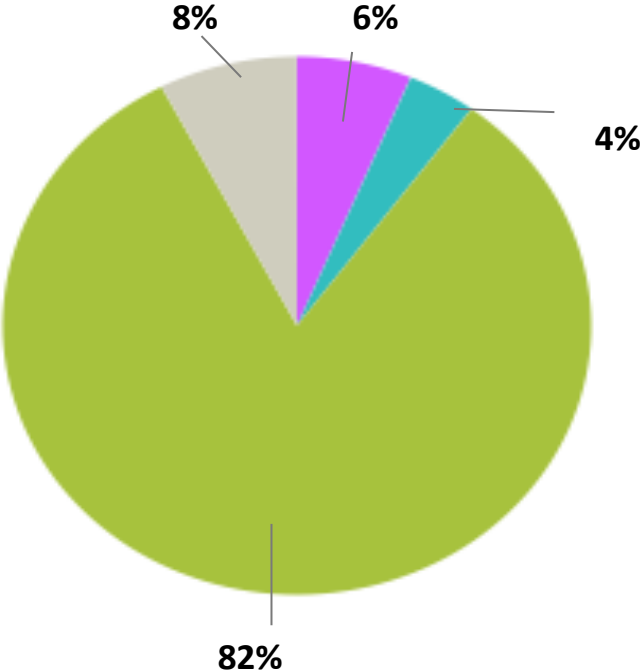

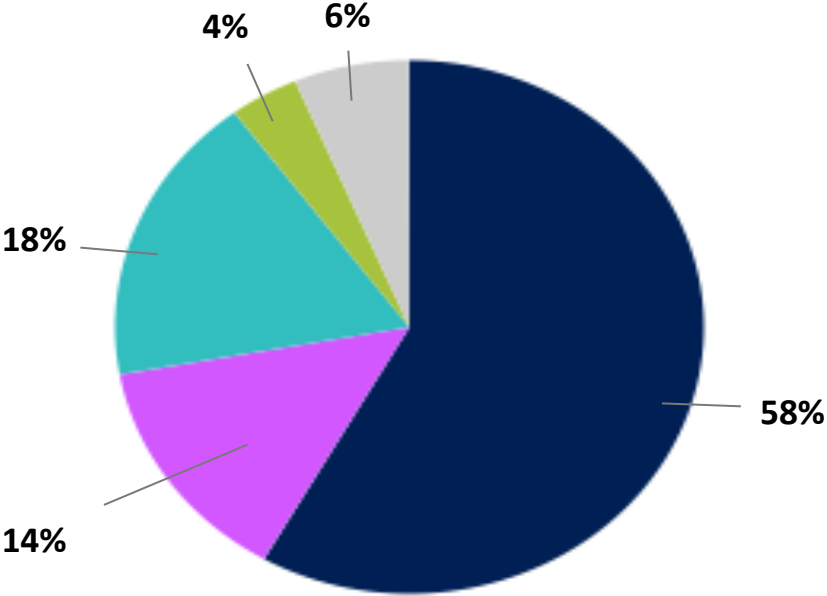

Gender

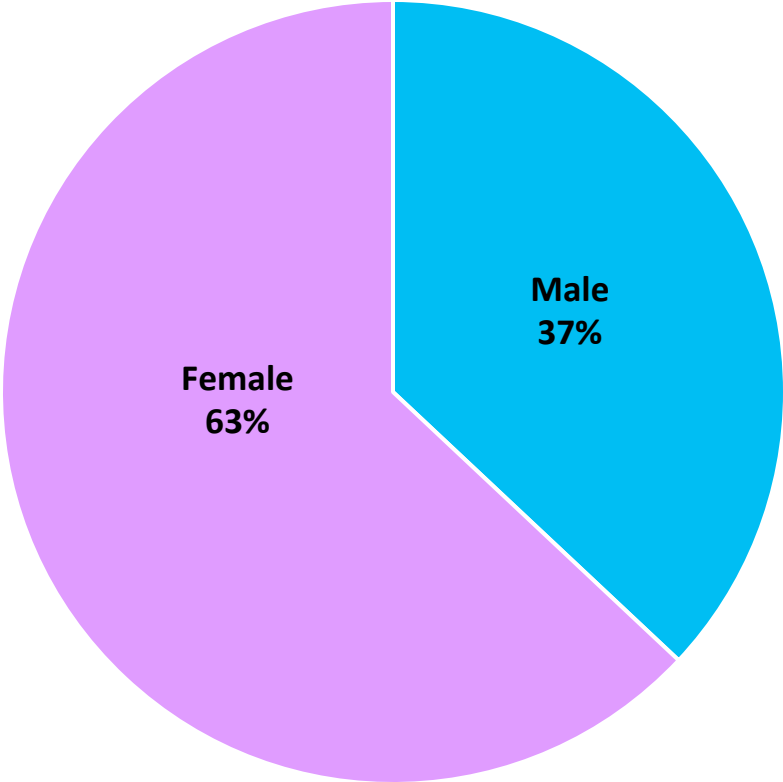

Were you familiar with AltaMed Health Services before attending this event?

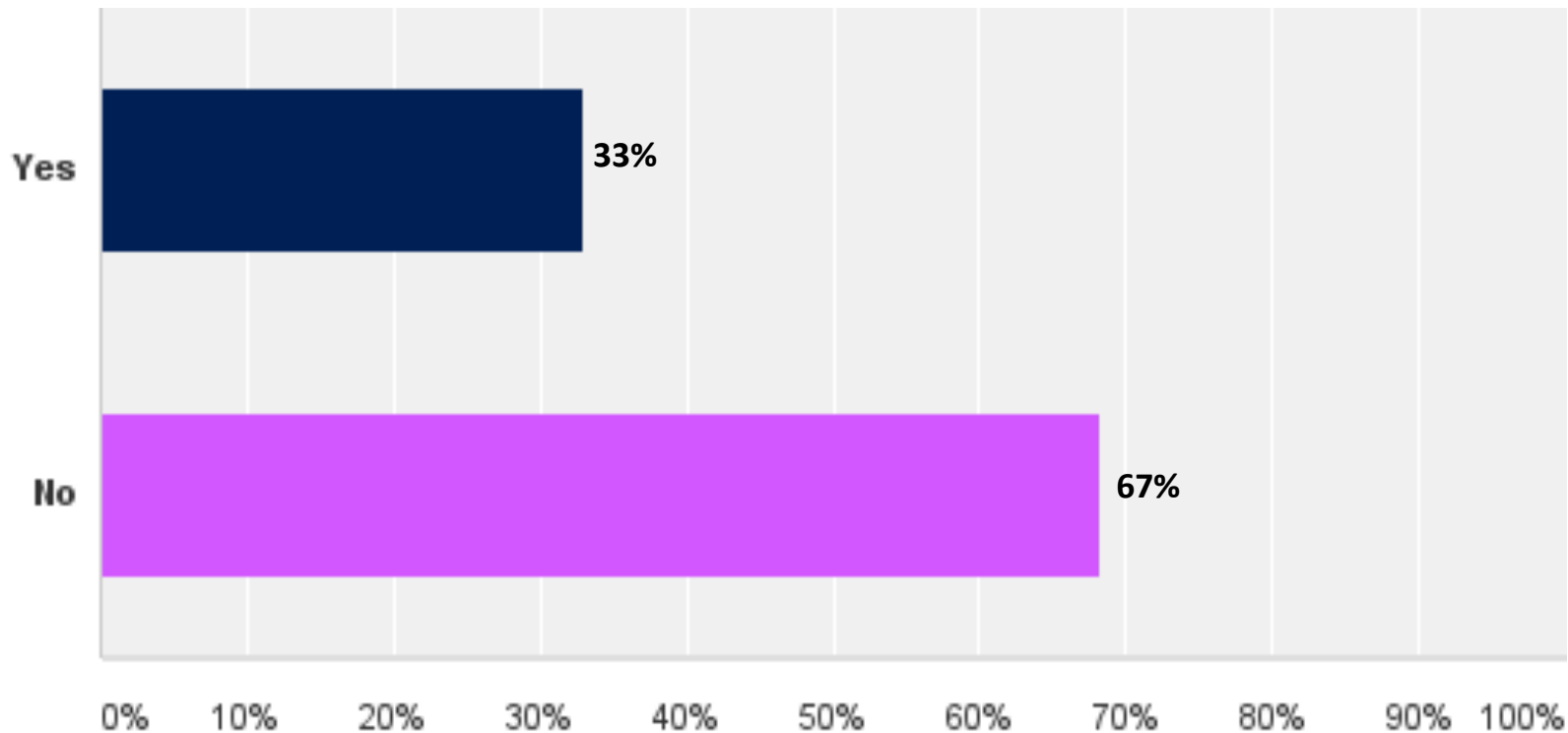

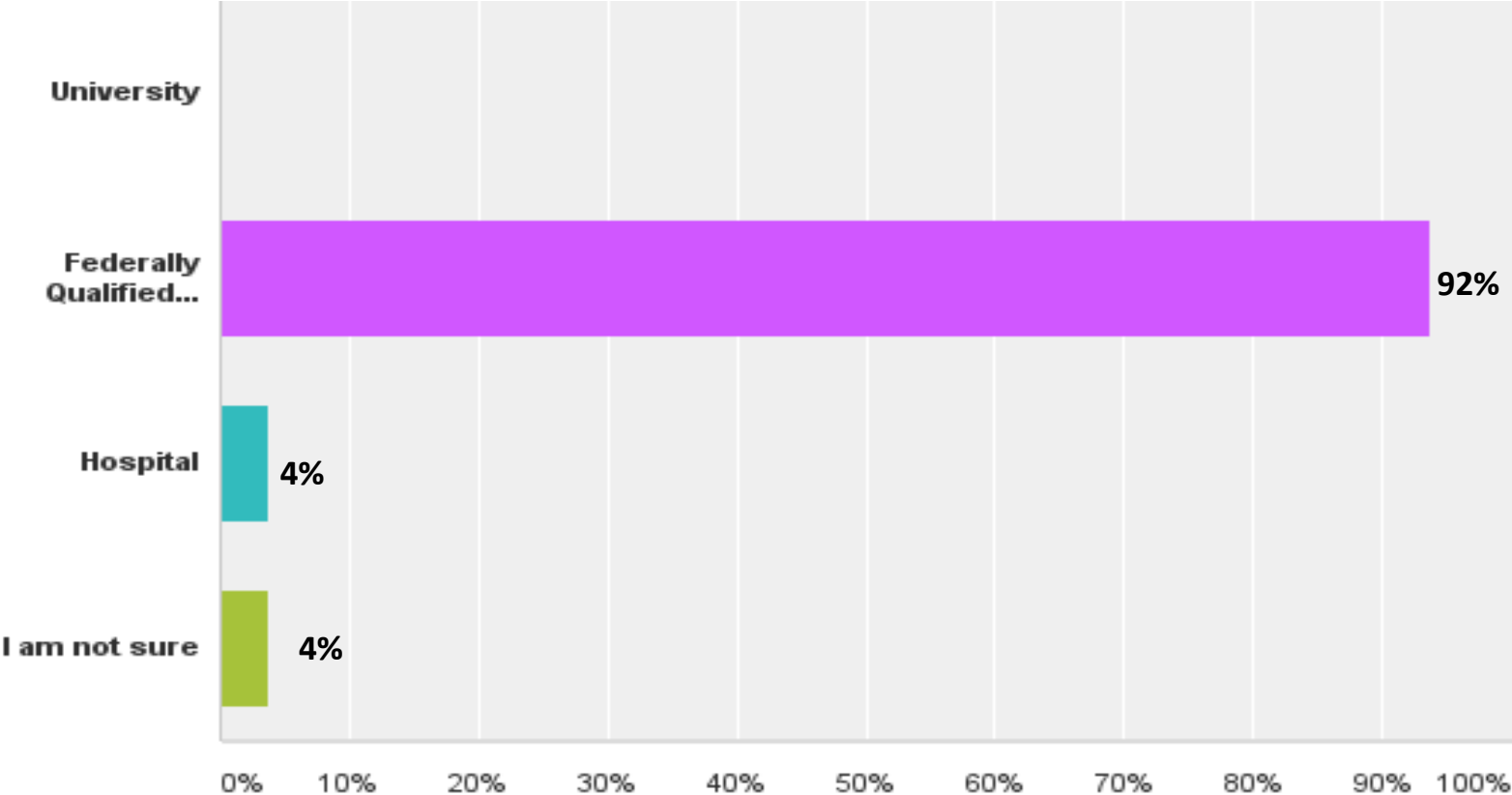
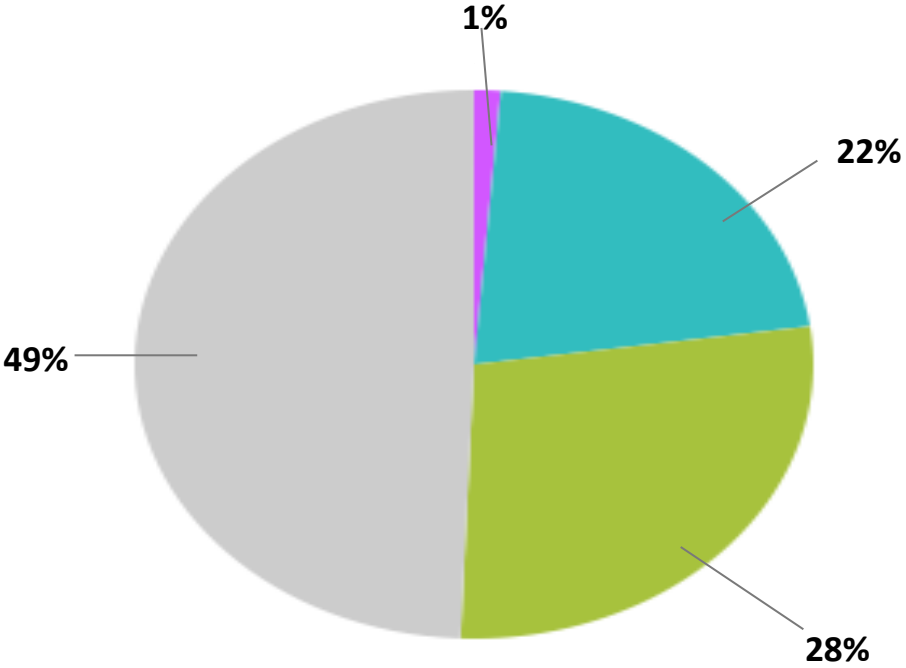

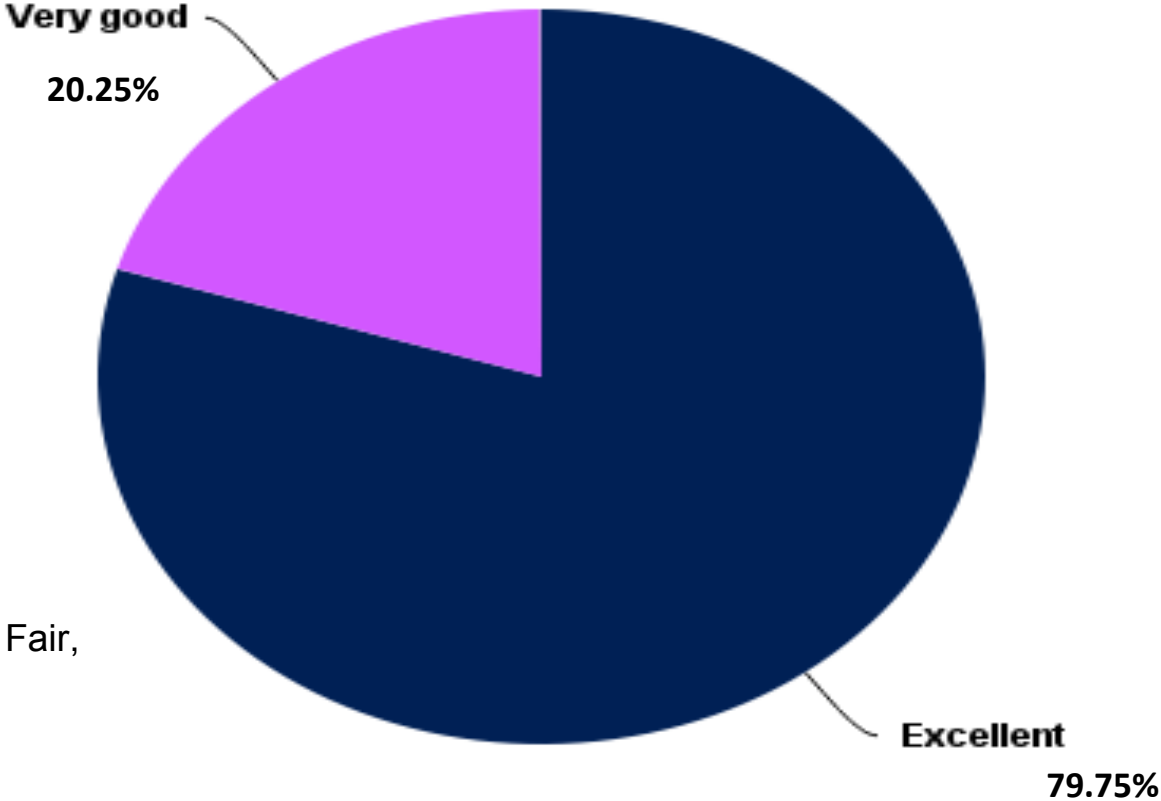
After attending this conference, how confident are you that you will become a healthcare professional?

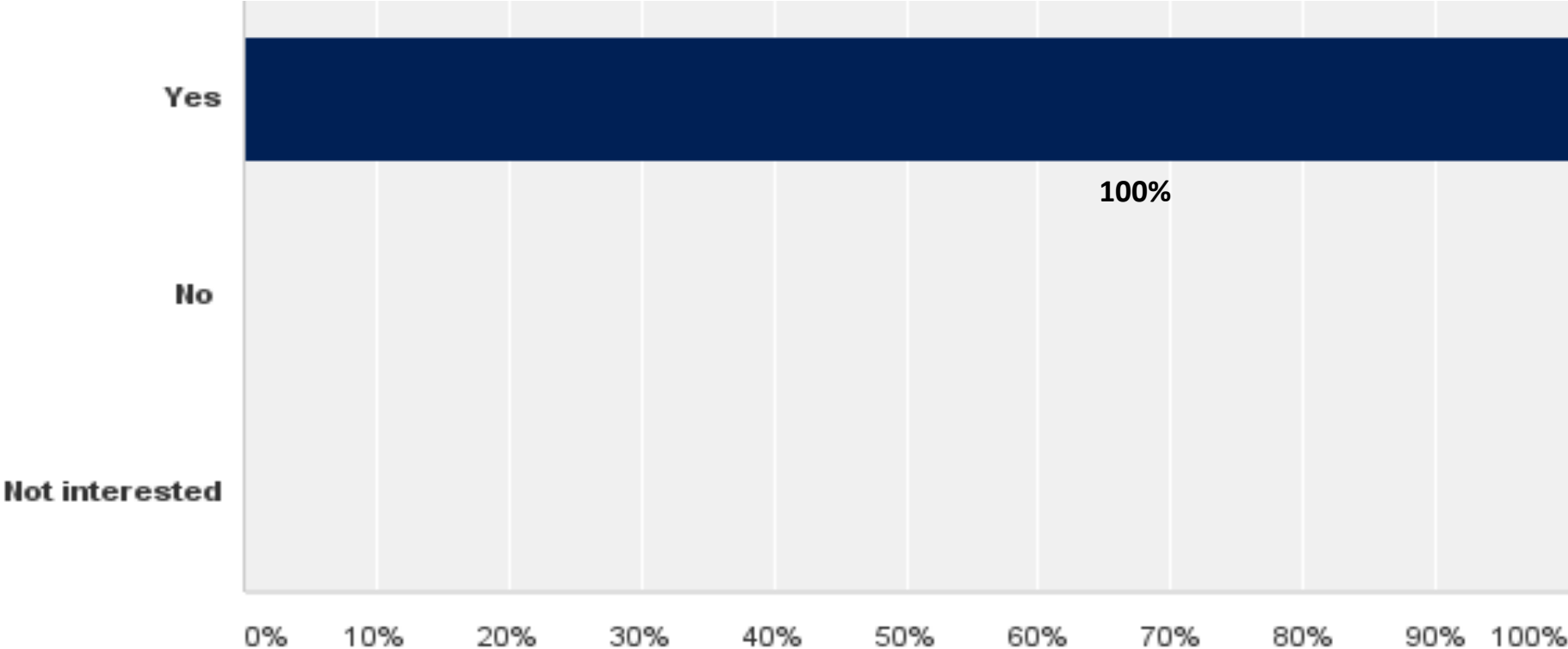
Overall, how would you rate the event?



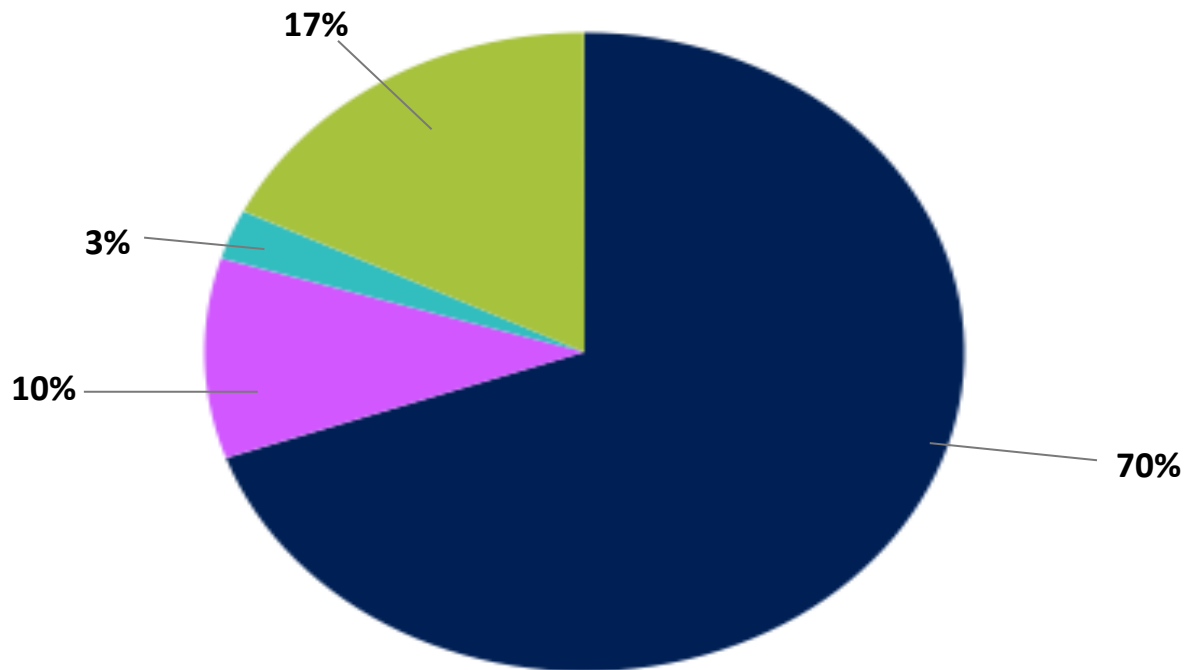
